London Hazards Centre was founded by the GLC in 1984 shortly before the Tories abolished it. We received £100k pa from London Councils to fund the work of LHC staff working with national and local authority H&S inspectors and professional advisers and national and local trade union and local community activists without prejudice on a not-for-profit basis to help their everyone in London to protect their living conditions from careless councils and unscrupulous profit-prioritising employers, landlords and traders.

The challenges most people in London face today are far more difficult than they were 40 years ago. We were forced to make all staff redundant after London Councils cancelled our funding in 2012, the same year the prime minister declared his intention to tackle the "health and safety monster" because it "hampers business growth". Just as he intended, the network of proactive professional national and local authority H&S inspectors and advisers we depended on to maintain reasonable public safety standards in London no longer exists. Although we're still campaigning for a safer London without prejudice, we cannot make a significant difference without consistent trade union funding.
